The Skills Bootcamp is designed to give people an opportunity to complete training and work placements across various settings in Health & Social Care. The WCCH have been working closely with the Wakefield District Health and Care Partnership to deliver Skills Bootcamp for Health & Social Care Cohort 2.

We have been working with our services to offer frontline placement opportunities for learners across the district and have concluded the programme this month with mock interviews.

We have provided the learners with insight into the various careers available in Adult Social Care across Wakefield and we hope that this will help recruitment across the district.

At Wakefield Cares Careers Hub, we are continuing to support displaced workers in Wakefield, **80 displaced workers have been successfully matched with employers and offered sponsorship**. We are working with a further 63 displaced workers who are actively seeking employment and sponsorship and are required to secure employment before their right to remain in the UK expires.
