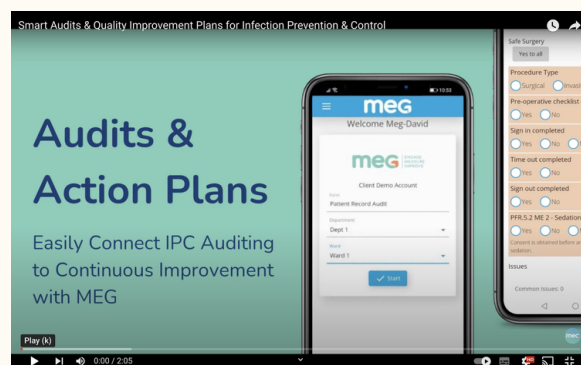


IPC Memo of the month

We are changing the way IPC audits will be completed within care homes, learning disability services and GP practices across Kirklees and Wakefield.



We will be introducing MEG | Healthcare Quality, Patient Safety & Compliance a digital audit platform that will replace our current audit process.

The new system will enable us and care settings to complete IPC audits and action plans electronically, providing a more streamlined, efficient and accessible approach to audit completion, monitoring and reporting
